Emergency: Mayon Volcano Eruption

Situation Report Number: 3 (as of 22 January 2018, 3:30 PM)

Alert Level 4 Raised Over Albay Province

- Today, at 12.34 PM, Mayon erupted and produced a 10-kilometer ash column into the sky
- Ashfall already reported in the municipalities of Guinobatan, Malilipot, Polangui, Ligao City, and Libon
- Classes are cancelled in all levels in Albay Province
- Danger zone is extended to 8 kilometers, from 6 kilometers, around the volcano
- Lava remains confined within the 6 kilometer permanent danger zone
- Residents were advised to wear masks and stay indoors

- EDUCO is closely monitoring events and currently coordinating with lead agencies
- All EDUCO personnel accounted for
- Next update will be on 23 January
